News from Design Technology


S4 and S6 had a very successful first two terms completing their Christmas tree project. Each student made 2 trees, one for home and one for sale in the school shop.

Simmonds pathway students have now moved on to looking at Escher lizards with a view to creating their own.

In the Hawking pathway we have been building knowledge and skills towards GCSE. We have had some exciting results from student Key ring projects.

Key rings have been designed using CAD (Computer Aided Design) which is then cut out and engraved on our Laser cutter.

Engravings are then coloured using nail varnish which is then sanded back leaving colours only in the engraving. This technique is valuable across a variety of products we make.
